To Import a Dictionary into Eclipse

1. In Eclipse, click on File and then Open Dictionary.

2. Provide a name for the new dictionary to be **imported**. This can also be the name of the Dictionary Jumpstart submodule that you're **importing**, e.g., automobiles. It will say the file doesn't exist. Would you like to create it? Click Yes. Now you'll see a clean, blank dictionary.

3. Click on File and Import.

To the bottom right, you'll see Eclipse or V8 Dictionary (.dix). Click on the drop down and select **Rich Text Format/CRE**.

Find where the **RTF**/CRE file is located. The files will display in the window below.

Click Open at the bottom right.

3. When asked, "Trim Redundant Entries?" Click Yes. Your dictionary entries will now appear in this file.

4. To enable conflict detection: Alt-U and go to the Edit Tab. On the right side, under Globaling and place a checkmark beside "Detect Conflicts."

6. Review the **imported** new dictionary thoroughly.

7. To Read this dictionary into your main dictionary, open your main dictionary and then do Alt-R and then select the dictionary that you would like to merge.
